

Limudei Kodesh Book List 2011-2012, Middle School.

- 6th grade: Most Judaic Studies Books are borrowed from the school
Students will purchase a workbook for Chumash at school when they arrive – \$12.
- 7th grade: **Tfilla:** ArtScroll Siddur (with the English translation). Metsudos Slichot (Make sure your Siddur and Slichot are labeled with the student's name on the outside) - to be used until grade 12.
Tanach: Every student should have a Hebrew Tanach (Koren or Simanim edition) and **also** a Hebrew-English Tanach (JPS or Artscroll editions recommended) to be used until 12th grade.
Chumash: Vayikra (Chumash + Rashi, Me'irat Einayim edition only)
Navi: Sefer Shmuel (Bet) Mikraot Gedolot Pe'er V'Hadar edition with Malbim
Talmud: Gemara Brachot, Vilna Edition (not Artscroll)
- 8th grade: **Tfilla:** ArtScroll Siddur (with the English translation). Metsudos Slichot (Make sure your Siddur and Slichot are labeled with the student's name on the outside)
Tanach: Every student should have a Hebrew Tanach (Koren or Simanim edition) and **also** a Hebrew-English Tanach (JPS or Artscroll editions) – to be used until 12th grade.
Chumash: Sefer Devarim (Zundel-Berman edition only)
Navi: Sefer Melachim (Aleph), Mikraot Gedolot Pe'er V'Hadar edition with Malbim (to be used next year too)
Talmud: Gemara Bava Metsi'a (Perek Hamafkid), Vilna Edition (not Artscroll).

All books can be found at the Israel Book store in Brookline. The staff will be happy to help you with your choices. For the ease of the classroom teaching experience we ask that you adhere to these editions only.

Please do not rely on extra Siddurim in the Shul (there will not be any). Make sure you bring the Art Scroll edition only.
