MAI TUITION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Is MAI Tuition a financial aid program?

No. It is a tuition discount program that is intended to help families lower the cost of day school tuition without applying for financial aid. It takes minutes to complete the application and minimal documentation (first two pages of IRS Form 1040) is required.

2. Who can apply?

- Families who are new to the school in either 2016-17 or 2017-18 school years.
- Families who applied for Financial Aid or MAI Tuition for the 2016-17 school year.
- Families with net worth less than \$1 Million (includes home equity and non-retirement investments).

3. Is this program a long-term commitment?

No. The entire MAI Tuition program is a pilot program, but increases in future enrollment will increase the likelihood that we will be able to continue the program in subsequent years.

4. Is "MAI Discount" based on the total number of children at Maimonides?

Yes.

5. Can a family use both "MAI Flex" and "MAI Discount"?

Yes, but the multi-child discount does not apply to the "MAI Flex" tuitions.

6. Is there any multi-year tuition guarantee?

Yes, but only for new K students in the MAI Flex program.

7. For eligible families, what is the deadline for application?

April 24th.

8. Can a family apply for both MAI and financial aid?

Yes.

9. Can a family using the MAI Tuition Program receive financial aid?

No.

10. Can a family use the Discover Day School (DDS) program with the MAI Tuition program?
