

Upper School Suggested Supply List

Binders or Spiral Notebooks for 10-12 subjects

Ruled paper for binders, and dividers and reinforcements for paper

24 pencils

24 pens (blue or black)

One pencil case or box

2-3 erasers

One box of colored pencils or markers

3-4 highlighters (different colors)

Glue stick

Scissors

Ruler

At least 6 packages of 3 X 5 index cards

Post-It notes – some Post-It Flags, some 3” X 3”

Several sheets of Poster Board, 22” X 28”, for projects

Box of tissues for locker

Water Bottle

Optional for Boys, but suggested for locker:

Spare Kippot, Tzitzit, and collared shirt

Optional for Girls, but suggested for locker:

Long skirt and extra sweater

All students are required to have a graphing calculator (one of many in the TI-84 series). We recommend the slightly more expensive color version – TI-84ce – for its speed, operating system, and clearer display. It is available here:
